<sup>ii</sup> FY 2016 Budget request did not propose separate funding for the HUD-VASH vouchers but instead proposed\$177.5 million for voucher assistance for families, veterans, and tribal households experiencing homelessness, as well as for domestic violence victims.

<sup>iii</sup> The House FY 2016 THUD bill further prohibited the transfer, reprogramming, or credit of any funds to HTF.
