• Funding Priorities

Redevelopment Plan (2018 Update)

- Identify public and private partners, commitments, and resources
- Housing and non-housing development
- Clear boundaries, goals, and action steps



• Funding Priorities – Cont.

Opportunity Area

- Access to high performing schools, transportation and employment
- Census tract with 15% or lower poverty rate
- Family developments
- Affirmative Marketing Plan
 - Special Marketing Reserve



- Selection Criteria
 - No new construction/conversion developments where a total of publically subsidized housing units equal more than 20% of all units located in census tract
 - No more than 50 affordable units in one development*
 - In Kansas City and St. Louis, no new developments within 1 mile radius for 2 fiscal year funding cycles, and previous developments have 90% Occupancy



- Communication Public Housing Authorities
 - 132 PHAs in Missouri
 - 2013 Consolidated Plan zero PHA involvement
 - Goal to increase participation



- Missouri Chapter of NAHRO
 - Membership Organization of 100+ PHAs
 - Attended Conferences
 - Regular Conference Calls with Officers
 - Requested Voluntary PHA Involvement
 - 25 PHAs responded
 - Answered PHA targeted questions in Consolidated Plan



- Other Communication Steps
 - Constant Contact Lists
 - Fair Housing and housing discrimination presentations at all larger MHDC meetings
 - Increased Public Hearings and Webinars
 - Surveys
 - Almost 1,000 responses



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
