Plaintiffs and Defendants, through their respective counsel, jointly moved to strike the hearing on the Temporary Restraining Order ("TRO") currently set for Thursday, April 25, 2019 and to set a briefing schedule for the Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction (the "Motion").

Based on the parties' Joint Motion and Defendants' agreement to stay the effective date of Mortgagee Letter 19-06² for 90 days from the entry of the order adopting this schedule, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Motion³ is GRANTED. The hearing scheduled for Thursday, April 25, 2019 is STRICKEN.

As to Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction,⁴ IT IS FURTHER ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Plaintiffs shall produce the materials required by the April 23, 2019 order⁵ on or before Wednesday, May 8, 2019.
- 2. Defendants shall file their short and plain statement required under DUCivR 7-4 and their response brief to Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunction on or before Wednesday, May 22, 2019.
- 3. Plaintiffs shall file their reply brief in support of their motion for preliminary injunction on or before 14 days after the Defendants file their response brief.⁶
